How the spelling cards are colour-coded

Prefix — a word part added to the front (e.g. mis-, non-, inter-)

misread

Root / base — the main meaning part of the word

misread

Suffix — a word part added to the end (e.g. -ion, -ian, -able)

action

Syllables — non-morphology words are split into syllables (alternating blues)

Each page = one lesson. The tiny code in the corner shows the term, week and lesson (e.g. Autumn 1 W1L1).
